TRAVEL FOR PEOPLE WHO WANT IT THE HARD WAY @

You can fly on every available airport in the Netherlands, and from there travel by train. (Amsterdam is the most convenient, but Eindhoven will do also)

You can travel by train to Lelystad central station (from every airport) it will cost you 1-3 hours, from there you taken the bus to Emmeloord and from Emmeloord you take the bus to Bant, then it is about 5 km walking (if possible we will pick you up)

You can book the train tickets quit easy online on www.ns.nl, you can switch to English, you book 2nd class, no discount one way tickets, so one one-way ticket for coming and one for going ⑤, in the Netherlands we don't have fixed seats in the train and also you can use the train ticket all day long. So there is no fixed time. You can also go out and back in, so you can go from Schiphol to Amsterdam central and go a few hours to the city and then go back in the train and go to Lelystad. we calculate them of course for the travel costs. (from Eindhoven single trip is 21,50, from Amsterdam is 11,50, this is in your total costs for the travel.

As soon as you found tickets then let me know and i will help you with the rest ©, at least try to be in time before the start and don't leave before the end! We cannot stay longer then the program nights in the venue. You are allowed to come earlier or leave later if you want to spend some time in the Netherlands extra. Of course, then the hostel and food will be for your own costs.

Summary of the project:

This is a project of Rock Solid Foundation. it is a follow up of the partnership building activity between already existing partners in EVS placings who are partly designed for working with NEET and youngsters with fewer opportunities about all the aspects of EVS.

The main objectives and goals are to improve the quality of EVS projects and to make the partnerships stronger and clearer between the different actors in the EVS placements. In parallel we will analyze and learn about the new Program, European Solidarity Corps which Guide we expect to be published by the implementation of the project.

The main goal of EVS is of course that volunteers experience a personal growth because of the EVS, especially if we are dealing with NEET and lesser opportunities! this also is the audience of most of our participating partners. from all the partners will come someone that is directly involved with EVS, in this way the direct impact on the EVS placements will be much bigger then when we ask for random participants.

During our research and with many interviews we noticed many partnering organisations have a need for further training and deepening of the existing relationships, better division of tasks and responsibilities between organisations, also cooperation, preparation and evaluation are important topics in this project.

several topics will be part of the project. Which parts should be done by SO, HO and CO and Volunteer?, What are exactly all the rules regarding EVS? which items are overlooked many times in an application but also in a real placement? how important is it to have separate mentors who can be intermediator between all the actors in the project? what do we do for aftercare of the volunteer after the EVS is ended? this and many other questions were the base for writing this partnership building activity.

All the participating organisations are already part of this active network and will select participants that are involved and responsible in their organisation for EVS. the involved countries are: Netherlands, Germany, Ukraine, Italy, Greece, Austria, Georgia, Romania, Slovenia, Tunisia, Spain, Armenia, Slovakia, Russian federation, Moldova, Belarus, Jordan, Cyprus, Hungary and Turkey.

it must be a project including the partnering countries because they are in reality having EVS placements in the Netherlands through the Rock solid Foundation.

The complete activity is build on Non-formal learning activities with a big variation on methods, also to teach the participating partners how to use them, but also the impact is proven to be better then from formal learning methods. The impact on Participants as well on organisations will be big. also the long term impact in all of Europe, because it will result in better EVS placements with better results, others will learn and copy-paste, and we hope to repeat this in the future more times with a growing network.
